# COVID 19 Test Types

**PCR testing** look for active infection

**PCR tests goal** is to:

- ▶ Identify sick and contagious people
- ▶ Isolate and contain spread

**PCR Tests offered by both clinics**

**Serology tests** look for antibodies in the blood

**Antibodies** are proteins that can fight off infection

**IgG typically develops 10-14 days after infection**

**Serology tests goal** is to understand:

- ▶ Who is infected
- ▶ How it is spreading

**Objective of surveillance testing**

- ▶ Provide incidence of infection
- ▶ Guide control measures, such as social distancing

# March 2020 COVID19 Disease Prevalence

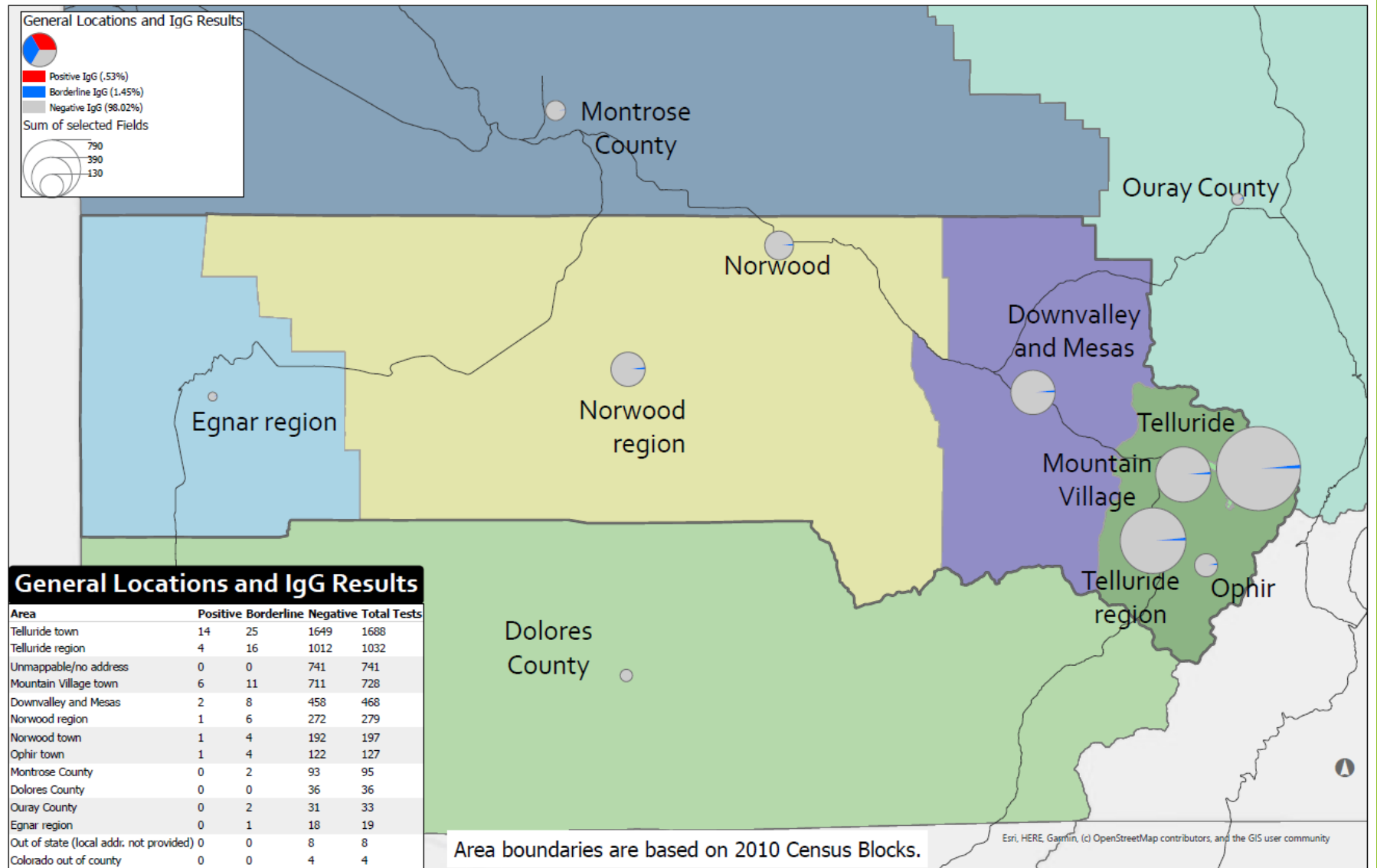
## IgG Test Results

Total: 5,455

Positive: 29 (0.53%)

Borderline: 79 (1.45%)

Negative: 5,347  
(98.02%)

# Testing

- ▶ Availability
  - ▶ Results turn around time
  - ▶ Test kits and supplies
- ▶ Reliability
  - ▶ Specificity and sensitivity
  - ▶ Validation
  - ▶ Updates with FDA testing process
- ▶ Cost
  - ▶ Staffing
  - ▶ Community trust
  - ▶ Resources: PPE, volunteers, equipment
- ▶ Methods
  - ▶ Blood draw vs. Prick
  - ▶ Turn around time

# Timing

- ▶ PH Needs:
  - ▶ Seroconversions at time of testing
  - ▶ Change in public health orders and movement
  - ▶ Decreased social distancing measures
- ▶ Resource considerations
  - ▶ Wildfires and staffing
  - ▶ Summertime turn out
  - ▶ Flu season
  - ▶ School
  - ▶ COVID surge or waves
